

LA HIGUERA

• MAULE VALLEY •

90 ha / 222 ac planted

LOCATION:

TerraNoble vineyards and winery are located in the highest zone of Maule Valley, in an area called Valle del Claro.

CLIMATE:

A bright sunshine, appropriate soils and clearly defined seasons are revealed in this valley of sub-humid Mediterranean climate, which receives 700 mm annual rainfall. Sunlight, water and soil combine and alternate wisely in warm days and cold nights. These optimum conditions generate a wide thermal fluctuation from 15°C to 18°C, which perfectly adequate, and enables optimum growing and ripening of our fine varieties.

SOIL:

Extensive zone with a slightly wavy topography and soils of sedimentary alluvial, fluvioglacial and colluvial origin located between 200-400 m above the sea level.

PLANTED VARIETIES:

Carmenere, Merlot, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Grenache.

WINE CHARACTERISTICS:

La Higuera presents unique characteristics for growing late-ripening varieties such as Merlot, producing great fruit presence and incredible fresh wines. Carmenere –as a late-ripening variety– adapts greatly to semi-cold climate, expressing itself through wines of great fruit presence, sweet and soft tannins with excellent freshness in mouth.
