LOCATION:

Los Lingues is located in the northwest area of Colchagua Valley, where the Coastal Range and the Andean Range get together.

Our vineyards are situated on the foothills of the Andes Mountains, where the unique tipicity of this valley expresses the best.

CLIMATE:

Los Lingues presents a tempered Mediterranean microclimate unique in Colchagua Valley. The Andean influence results in cold nights, with thermal oscillations that can vary up to 20°C between day and night, allowing a perfect ripening and great concentration in its grapes.

The breeze appearing in Los Lingues during the day, allows stable ventilation and uniform temperature of vineyards permitting a perfect ripening that gives birth to valley tipicity.

SOIL:

Soils are of alluvial-colluvial origin, ranging from fine sand to clay and granite. They are low fertility and good drainage soils.

PLANTED VARIETIES:

Cabernet Sauvignon, Carmenere, Syrah and Petit Verdot.

WINE CHARACTERISTICS:

Los Lingues presents an exclusive tipicity in Chile offering wines of soft and mature tannins, of great volume in mouth, fresh and with a unique natural sweetness.
