TERRANOBLE ACHIEVES SUSTAINABLE WINE OF CHILE RECERTIFICATION

Once again, TerraNoble renewed its Sustainable Wine of Chile certification created by the R&D Consortium made up of Wines of Chile and the most prestigious universities in our country.

The code requires that we periodically submit to an audit that reviews the winery's performance on sustainability issues in the vineyard, the winery, and in its relationship with the community.

In our case, we were audited in the practices we follow in our fields (Green code) both in respect of the environment, efficient use of water and management in general, as well as the care of the teams that work in the vineyard. Likewise, the audit covered energy efficiency projects, waste management and safety standards implemented in our warehouse and production area (red code). Finally, we were also audited in relation to our actions towards our team, relationships with suppliers, as well as in the promotion of responsible consumption in our communications (orange code).

In the words of Carola Rivas, responsible for the implementation of the code, "we are very happy with this new certification in which we obtained scores above the standard, especially in the green code with an outstanding score of 95.4%, which demonstrates our commitment as a team on such a relevant issue."
